Description of session's formats

A: TALKS

Talks are meetings of a small group of participants where a topic presented by one or two members of the group is discussed

Schedule and length: one hour, from 18.00 to 19.00 hrs.

Presentation modality: it is open to the participation of several speakers.

Example: a group studying eating disorders of a certain institution presents a clinic case to be commented by the whole group.

To apply: send an abstract to the Scientific Committee to be accepted.

B: THEMATIC COFFEES

Thematic Coffees are informal conversations held with a small group of participants (8 at most), about a specific issue chosen by one or two speakers.

Schedule and length: one hour, at breakfast time –it includes a cup of coffee. From 7.45 to 8.45 A.M.

Presentation modality: Just one or two speakers.

Example: A speaker chooses the theme “Analytic Psychology in the University”, and he/she invites the group to discuss the issue presented.

To apply: send an abstract to the Scientific Committee to be accepted.

C: ROUND TABLES

Round tables are presentations of works that include the topic of the Congress: “Eros and Power”. Two works will be presented in each table.

Schedule and length: one and a half hour, from 9.00 to 10.30 in the morning, and from 16.00 to 17.30 in the afternoon. Each speaker will have 30 minutes to present his/her work. The final 30 minutes will be used for questions and discussion with the public.

Presentation modality: just one or two speakers for each work.

To apply: send an abstract to the Scientific Committee to be accepted.

D: POSTERS

Posters are graphic exhibitions of works and must have the following characteristics:

- The poster must adapt to the following measures: 90 cms. wide x 1,20cms height
- The poster should be elaborated in an appropriate paper to be hung.
- As much as possible, it should be attractive, well organized and self-explanatory.
- Bibliographic references should follow the APA norms.

Schedule and length: The Scientific Committee will determine the day and length of the posters exhibitions.

Presentation modality: just two exhibitors for each work. The author(s) must be at the place where the poster is exhibited during the time stipulated for its exhibition, in order to answer questions and interchange ideas with the participants. The assembly and disassembly of the poster will be the exclusive responsibility of the author.

To apply: Send an abstract will to the Scientific Committee in order to be accepted.

E: WORKSHOPS

Workshops are group instances where a topic is discussed from the theoretical and experiential point of view (the number of participants will be decided by the speakers).

Schedule and length: One and a half hour from 16.00 to 17.30 in the afternoon.

Presentation modality: just one or two speakers.

To apply: An abstract must be sent to the Scientific Committee to be accepted.
