



## 1-year certificate course for practising clinicians

September 2020-July 2021

### **Certificate in Clinical Practice from a Jungian Perspective**

This unique new course is designed for practising clinicians (psychoanalysts, psychotherapists and counsellors) who wish to deepen their clinical understanding and are particularly interested in the Jungian approach practised at the Society of Analytical Psychology (SAP).

We have brought together some of the SAP's most senior and experienced practitioners and thinkers to deliver the course. The course takes place over 10 Saturdays and includes 30 hours of presentations and supervision masterclasses.

To be awarded a **Certificate of Completion** participants may choose to write a clinically oriented essay of 4000 words, drawing on the content of the course with reference to their clinical practice. Those attending who choose not to write an essay will be awarded a **Certificate of Attendance**.

#### **Course Format:**

10.00 – 13.30 with a 30-minute break for refreshments and socialising.

During the masterclass the presenter will work in front of the group with a participant on the case they present. Up to two cases can be supervised during each masterclass, followed by a discussion. The participants will be asked to select clinical material that resonates with the theme of each session and to submit their requests ahead of the session.
