POSTPONED TO 2023

Dear Friends and Jungian colleagues,

As you will no doubt be aware, organizing the **IX Latin American Congress 2021 has been a great challenge due to the uncertainty of the current climate**. We have tried to adapt to the uncertain circumstances in which we live with optimism and good spirit.

Our team has worked hard in keeping all of you updated; and we have worked closely with those who have supported us. This has made the workability of the Congress possible during the pandemic. We truly appreciate all your efforts.

As October's Congress has drawn nearer, we realized that Uruguay's borders would not be open to certain jurisdictions and might require quarantine on arrival. This situation, together with the difficult social and economic situation in Latin America, made us envisage the Congress as a three-day event.

After an extensive feasibility study, the Organizing Committee, together with the Latin American Analytical Psychology (CLAPA) Executive Committee, has concluded that, due to the limited organizational time, together with the loss of important face-to-face interaction, **the best option is to postpone the IX Latin American Congress 2021**.

Given that next year the XXII International Analytical Congress (IAAP) will be held in Buenos Aires, the Organizing Committee, together with CLAPA, **has resolved to postpone the Congress to October 2023 whilst keeping Uruguay as host country**.

Those colleagues who have already paid their registration fee will be able to defer registration to next Congress date. It would be a great help if you could not cancel your registration. Those who decide not to cancel will not incur the higher registration fee in 2023. **For those wishing to opt for reimbursement, please contact the Organizing Company (Congresos & Reuniones) at info@clapa-jung2021.org**

Moreover, those who choose to keep their registration fee and have submitted abstracts; these will be considered for evaluation by the Scientific Committee.
