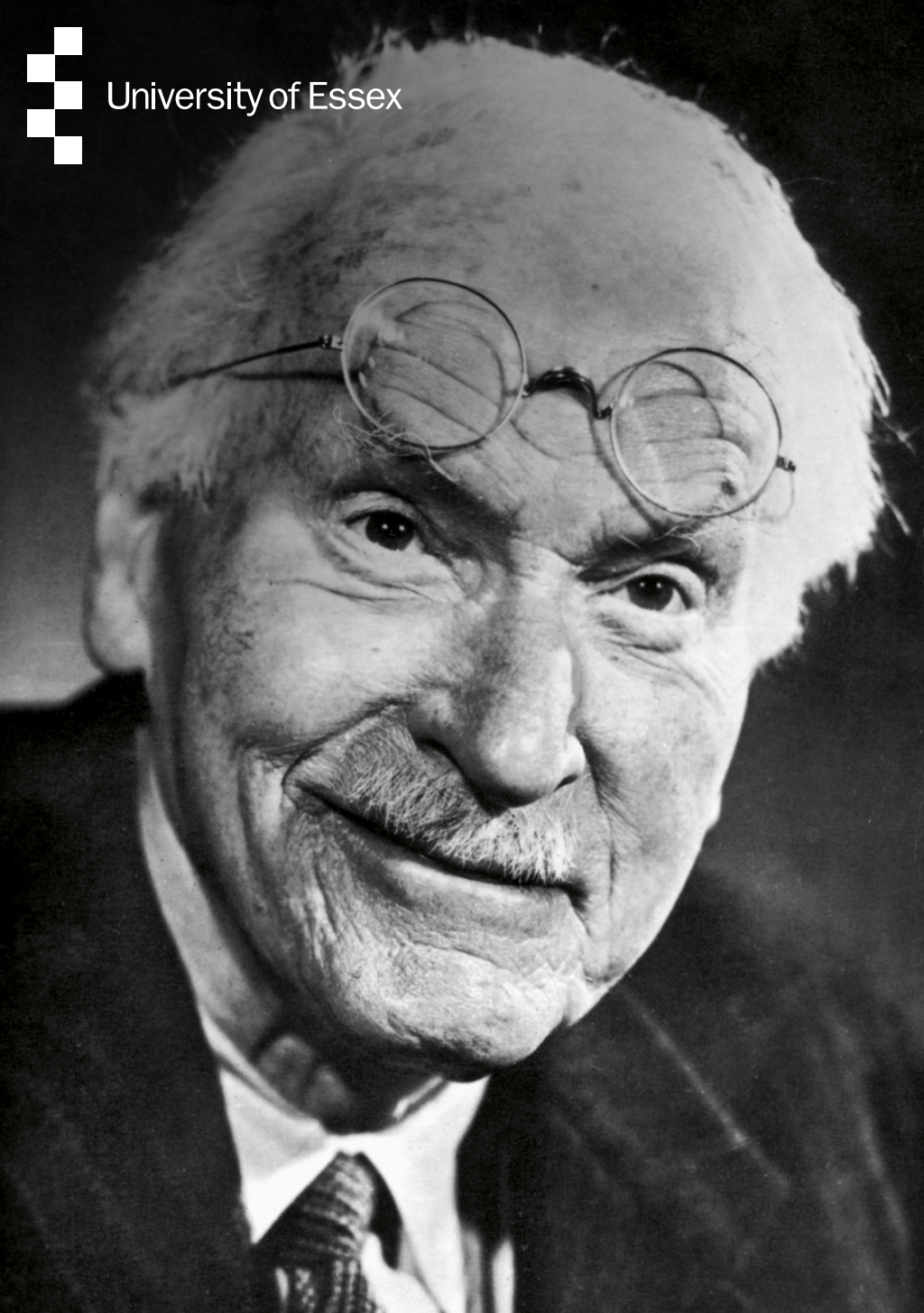

It is taught either in person (on our Colchester campus) or as an online course. It offers you the opportunity to learn from leading Jungian analysts and academics about the key texts, multiple contexts and core concepts of analytical psychology.

The module on applications of Jungian and Post-Jungian thought explores the possibility of a distinct, Jungian approach to Psychosocial Studies. It examines social and political issues relating to gender and sexuality, race, refugees, children's rights, religion, and the body.

The Department is a world-class centre for post-graduate research in psychoanalysis. Our MA can serve as a preparation for PhD research. Many qualified practitioners find the course an excellent means of deepening and grounding their understanding of Jungian clinical concepts and theory. For others the course leads them on to clinical training.
