Full Itinerary:

Day 01 (December 10) Qingdao to Tai'an

Accommodation: Holiday Inn Express Tai'an City Center

Day 02 (December 11) Tai'an to Qufu

【Mount Tai】 ⇒ 【Dai Temple】

Possible Accommodation: Qufu Atour Hotel

【Mount Tai】 (about 4 hours)



Mount Tai is located in the central part of Shandong Province, China. Since ancient times, the Chinese have revered Mount Tai, believing in the saying, “If Mount Tai is stable, so is the entire country”.

The primary attractions of Mount Tai include the Shibapan, South Heaven Gate, Heavenly Street, Jade Emperor Peak, and Sun Viewing Peak, where one can experience the heroism described by the famous line: “Meeting at the summit, all other mountains appear small”. Along the way, you can appreciate the breathtaking scenery of the Five Sacred Mountains and immerse yourself in the transcendent feeling of Mount Tai’s supreme status among them.

【Dai Temple】(about 1 hour)



The Dai Temple used to be the venue where emperors of the past dynasties held celebrations to worship heaven and earth and bestowed sacrifices to the God of Mount Tai.

Day 03 (December 12) Qufu-Yanzhou-Qufu

【Kong Family Mansion】



Kong Family Mansion was built in 1377 and it is the mansion of the eldest son of Confucius, also known as the Yansheng Mansion. The mansion where Confucius lived for generations, known as the “First Family in the World”, is a prominent aristocratic mansion that exists in the world.

【Temple of Confucius】



The Temple of Confucius is a temple to venerate Confucius who was the famous Chinese philosopher and educator of the Spring and Autumn period. Together with the Palace Museum in Beijing and Chengde Mountain Resort, it is called the three ancient architectural groups in ancient China. It is also the precedent and model of thousands of Confucius temples at home and abroad. The Confucian Temple, with its grand scale, majestic spirit, ancient age, and complete preservation, is called a “solitary example” in the history of world architecture by architect Sicheng Liang.

【Mount Ni】



Mount Ni is a hill about 30 km. The hill is culturally significant because it is traditionally regarded as the birthplace of Confucius. It is also the site of a historical temple dedicated to Shuliang He, the father of Confucius, a Confucian academy, and the Yusheng Memorial Temple. In 2016, a statue of Confucius was completed on the Mount. Standing at 72 meters, it is the tallest statue of Confucius in the world.

【Mencius Family Mansion】



Mencius Family Mansion, home to the descendants of Mencius for dynasties, is one of the largest and relatively well-preserved ancient architectural complexes in China, combining the functions of a government office and a residence.

【Mencius Temple】



The Mencius Temple, also known as the Yasheng Temple, is a five-courtyard complex where Mencius offered sacrifices in the past dynasties.

Day 04 (December 13) Qufu-Jinan

【Lingyan Temple】→【Baotu Spring】

【Lingyan Temple】(about 1 hour)



The Lingyan Temple first built in the Eastern Jin Dynasty, underwent significant reconstruction starting from the first year of the Zhengxing era in the Northern Wei Dynasty. It reached its zenith during the Tang Dynasty and featured prominent attractions like the Pizhi Pagoda and the Thousand Buddha Hall. With its rich Buddhist heritage, Lingyan Temple has been renowned alongside Qixia Temple in Nanjing, Guoqing Temple on Mount Tiantai in Zhejiang, and Yuquan Temple in Dangyang, Hubei, collectively referred to as the “Four Great Buddhist Monasteries” in China since the Tang Dynasty.

[Baotu Spring] (about 1.5 hour)



The Baotu Spring is a culturally significant artesian karst spring located in the city of Jinan, Shandong, China. It is mentioned in the Spring and Autumn Annals, one of the Five Classics of Chinese literature, and was declared the "Number One Spring under Heaven" by the Qianlong Emperor in the Qing dynasty.
