The program will be held solely in German and includes:

- **Opening Lecture and Performance by Doris Uhlich:** The multiple award-winning (Austrian Art Prize 2024) dancer and choreographer will open the conference with a unique performance, focusing on the relationship between humans and their bodies.
- **Impulse Lectures and Body Activation :** Each seminar day starts with keynote lectures and a short body activation under the motto "Move your ass. Your mind will follow" .
- **Lectures and Workshops:** A total of 17 lectures and 13 workshops will be held by renowned experts from Germany, Switzerland, and Austria. Workshops will not be streamed and can only be attended onsite. Online speakers: Gerhard Burda, Renate Daniel, Christa Futscher, Birgit Heintz, Patrick Jenni, Isabelle Meier, Judith Noske, Monika Rafalski, Christian Rösler, Konstantin Rößler, Magdalena Thur.
- **Evening Events:** Following the opening performance, there will be a sparkling wine reception with live music by the Vienna jazz band Soundstairs (featuring one of the teaching analyst from Austria). On Friday evening, participants will ride a historic streetcar to the wine district Grinzing, where they can enjoy a traditional Viennese dinner with wine pairing and classical Viennese wine music. On Saturday evening, there will be a dance night, where singer Valiente will take us on an inspiring musical journey centered on the theme of love.

The event takes place in the heart of Vienna, surrounded by museums, art galleries, parks, and much more. The location allows easy access by public transportation.
